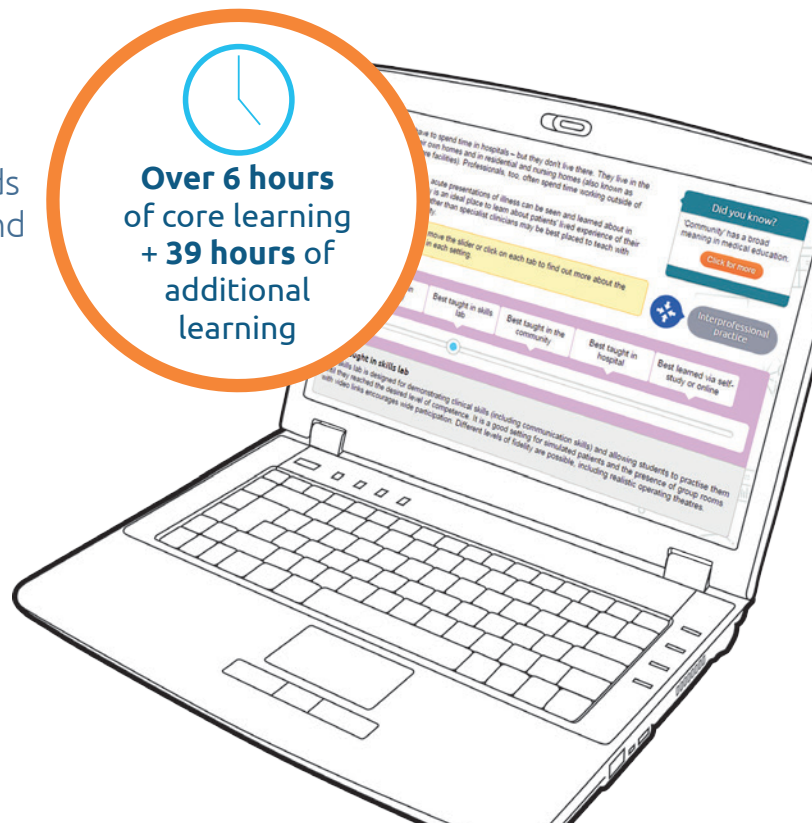
Teaching and Assessment for Medical Educators is an online programme to enhance teaching, learning, assessment, feedback and evaluation in medical education.

- The programme prompts medical educators to observe official requirements such as those set by the Academy of Medical Educators (UK).

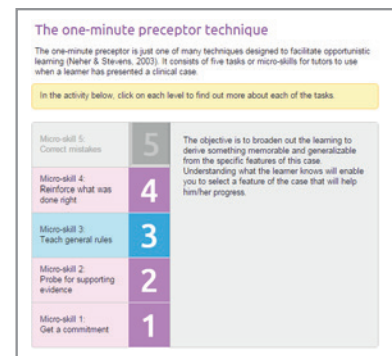
